GP Planning Ltd were commissioned in 2014 to undertake a review of Strategic Waste Policy across Waste Planning Authorities within the South East of UK. This was required to support market analysis being undertaken to identify potential sites suitable for the location of an In Vessel Composting Facility, to treat a mixture of food and green waste from London.

The review considered Strategic Waste Policy across 13 Waste Planning Authority Areas, within three primary clusters. In addition, the relationship of each waste policy area and London was considered, alongside waste site allocations. Furthermore, strategic level environmental constraints to development were also taken into account. As a result of the analysis, constraints and opportunities for each Waste Planning Authority were identified along with preferred locations or areas of suitability and individual development sites.

The client have subsequently identified a development site and are putting in place plans to development the In Vessel Composting Facility.
